





IT'S YOUR TURN / C'EST VOTRE TOUR

The garden plays with the turn of nature: wet, dry, hot or cold. And with the turn of the visitor: active or passive.

At one end, the garden rises 1.7 metres, creating an inclined plane featuring an access ladder, bench height boulders that are semi-bounded by wildflowers, an axis of wooden poles and trembling aspen. Sunken stones are also scattered throughout and collect rainwater.

Three sloped walls of the garden are cladded by darkened wood. The remaining wall is a meadow with a species composition that can change over time. Organic and synthetic hues of yellow unify these elements into a dynamic landscape that evolves with shifting climate conditions.

The garden is open to interpretation. To some, it may look like a life-sized board game, with rules created by one's own imagination. To others, it may resemble a Zen garden, a tranquil environment for escape or reflection. No matter one's reading, the garden asks us to be free to adapt to its ever-changing plan... Now, it's your turn.
