Everybody knows the story of the Three Little Pigs, But I'll let you in on a little secret and tell you my side of the story...

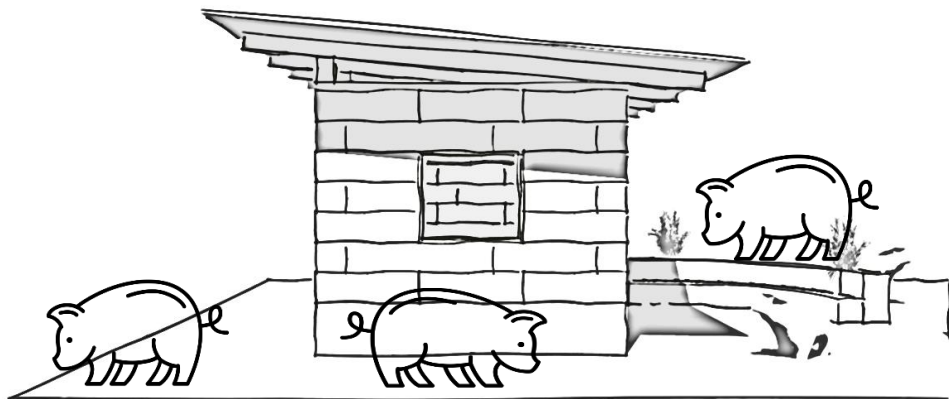
Once upon a time there were Three Little Pigs, each one had a different resource to build a house: straw, wood, and bricks.

SITE PLAN

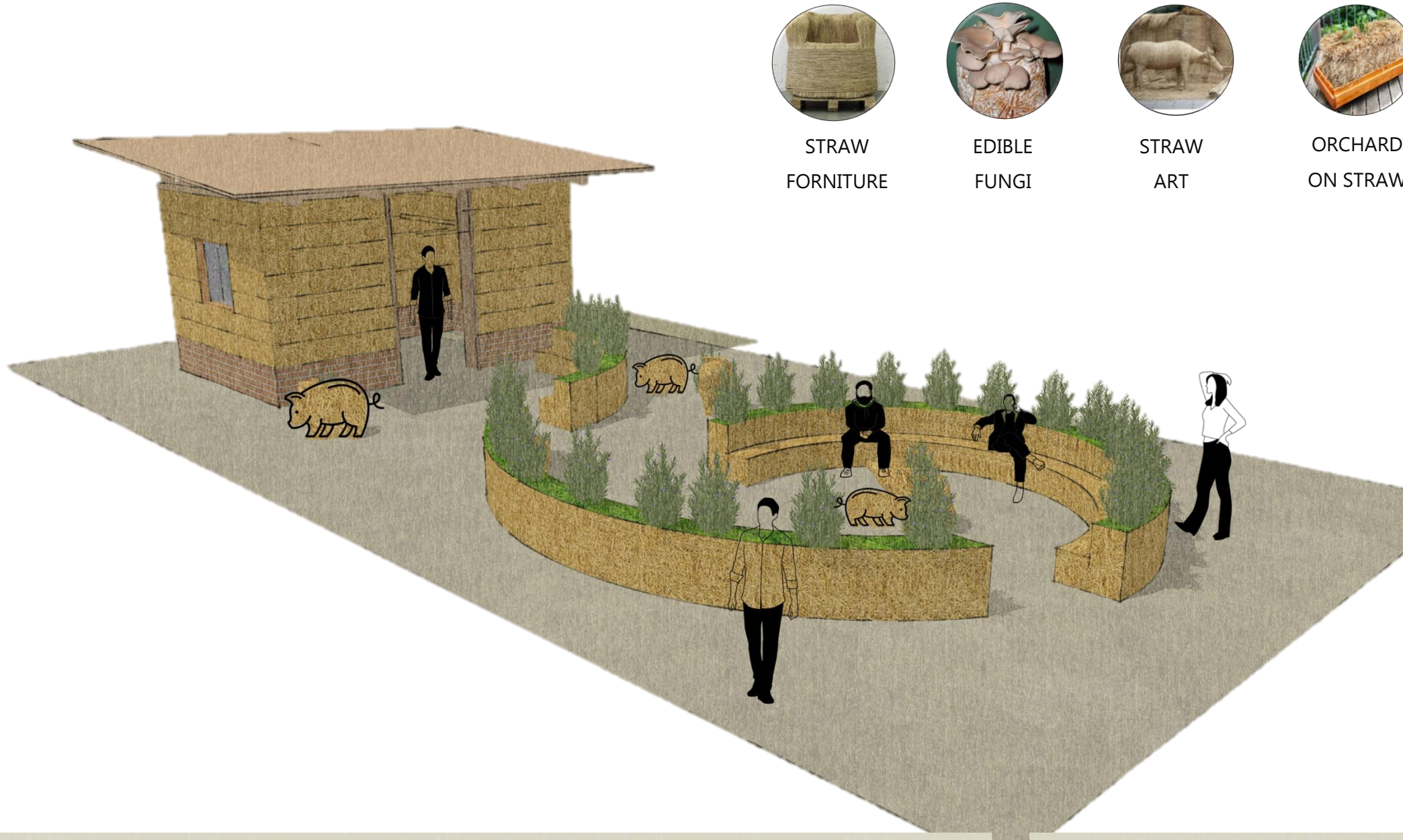

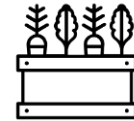

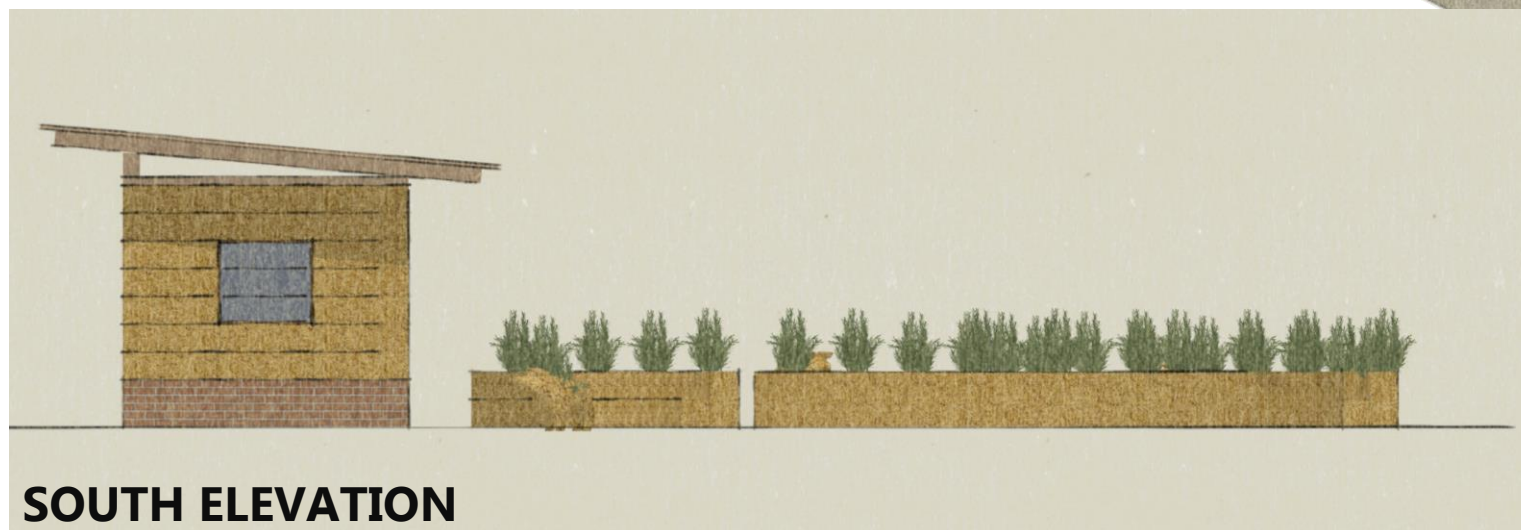

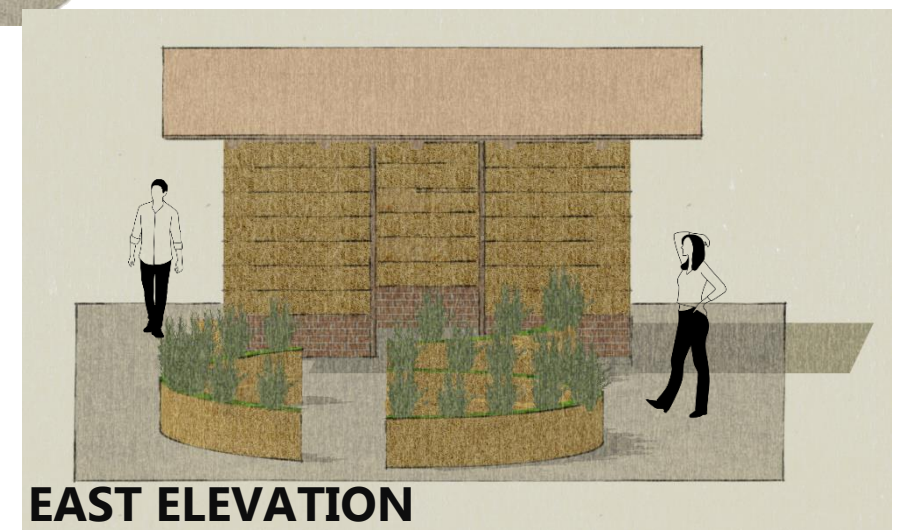
