### **DESIGN NOTES**

#### SHELTER

Roots emerge from the ground, originate from ecological roots, spread on the ground, build space, and weave a space for human civilization. Quebec's cold clothed wood is used as the material to build these four shelters. The underground roots break through the ground, spread and weave on the ground, and the land under our feet evokes our thinking about the neglected natural forces. The contour of each curved member is in the same plane, which is convenient for cutting and construction. The structure is assembled by means of notch lapping, which is easy to disassemble and assemble.
