this garden wants to be an example of current fashion. A trend that leads us to see aesthetics as the only point of reference.

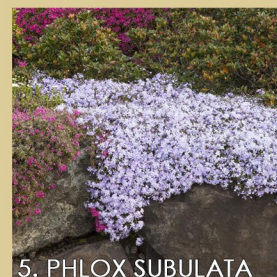
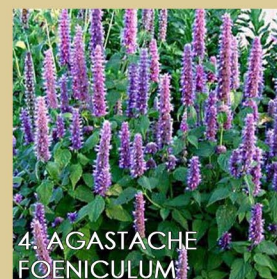
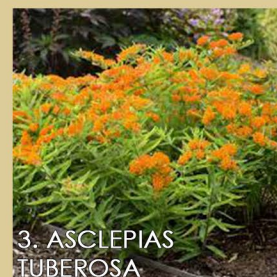
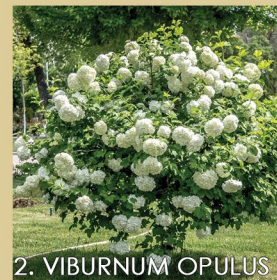
This garden represents the idea that we must overcome and for this reason we would like it to have aesthetically strong essences (better if alien) and regular shapes. All on an English lawn.

PLANT SELECTION: natural garden

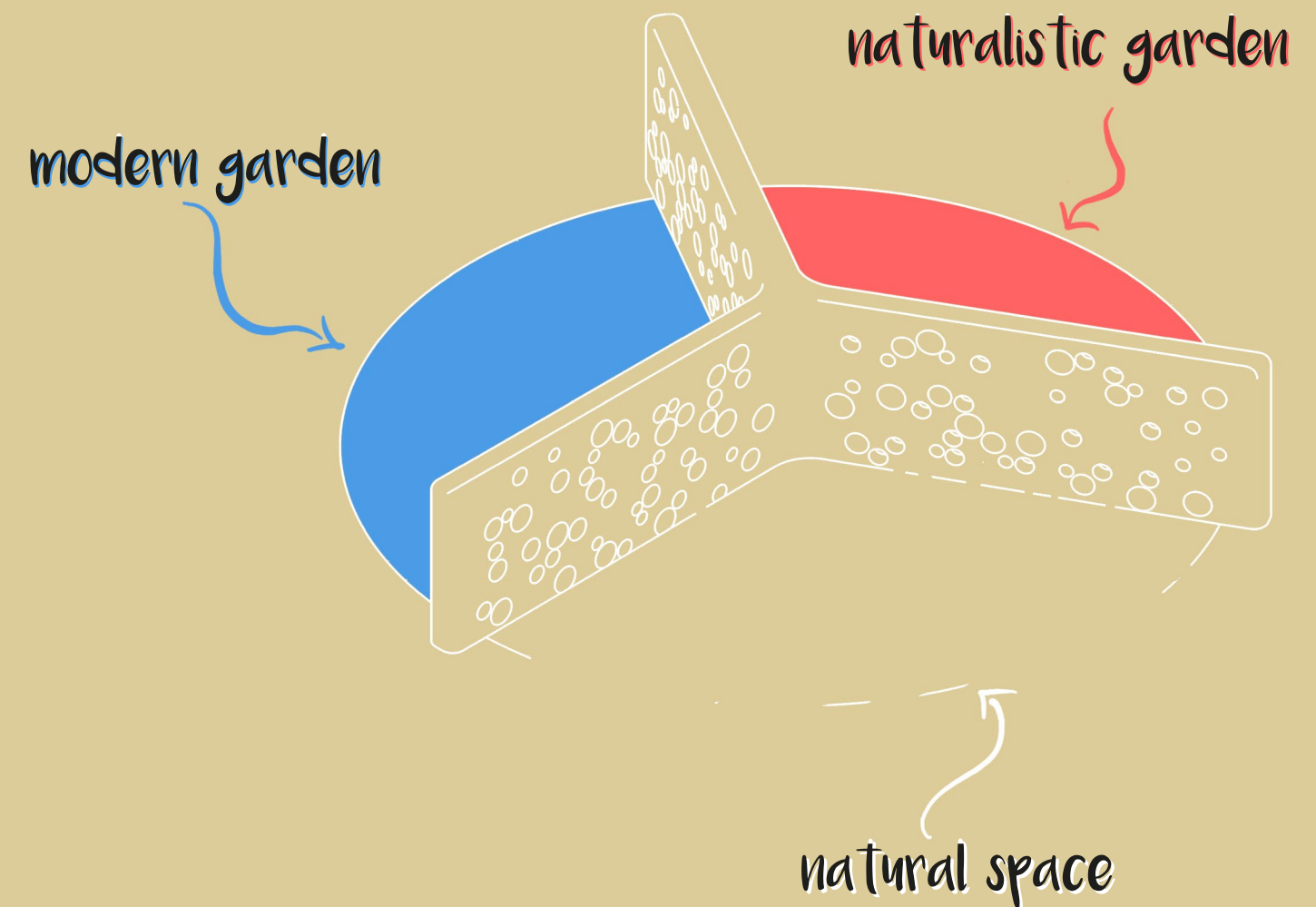

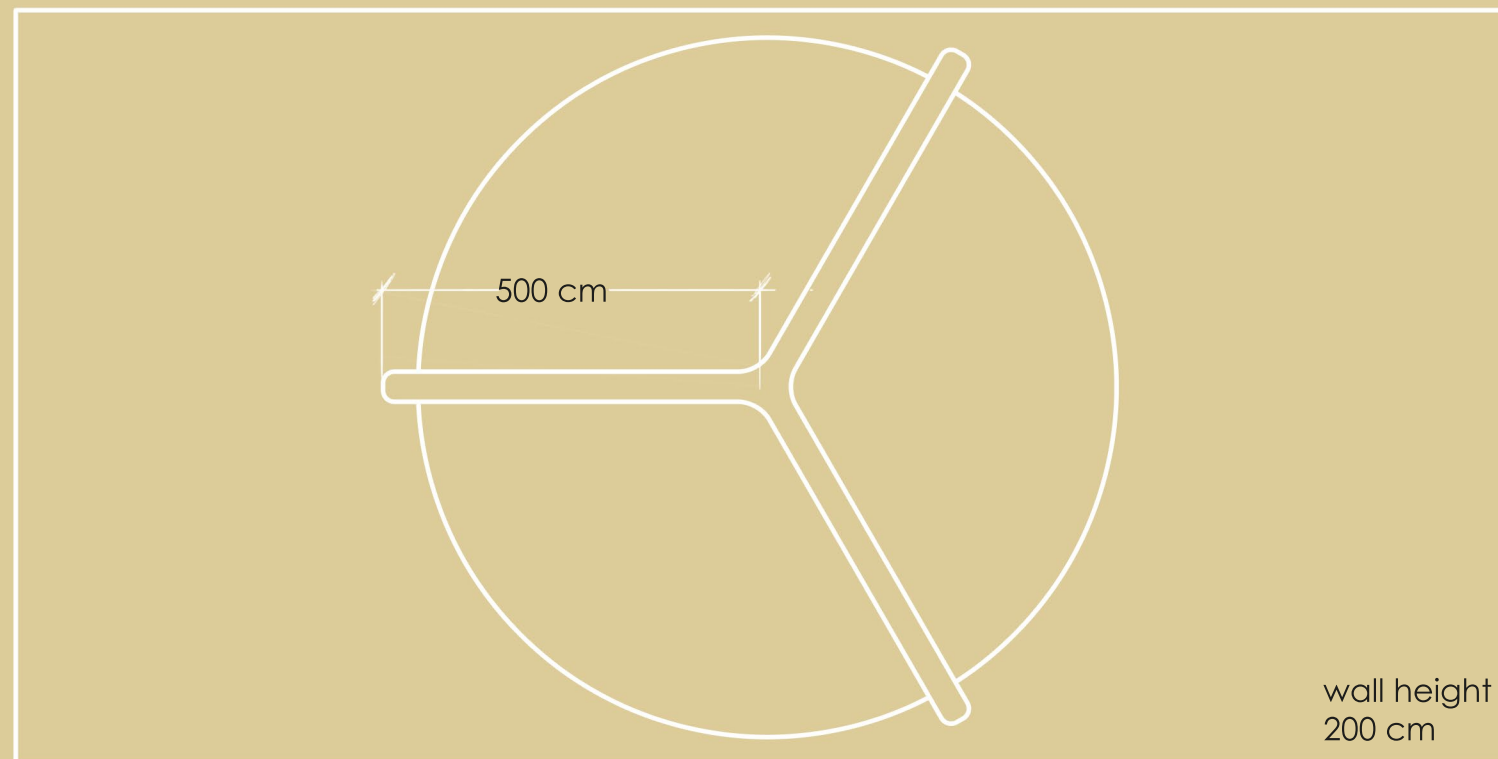
