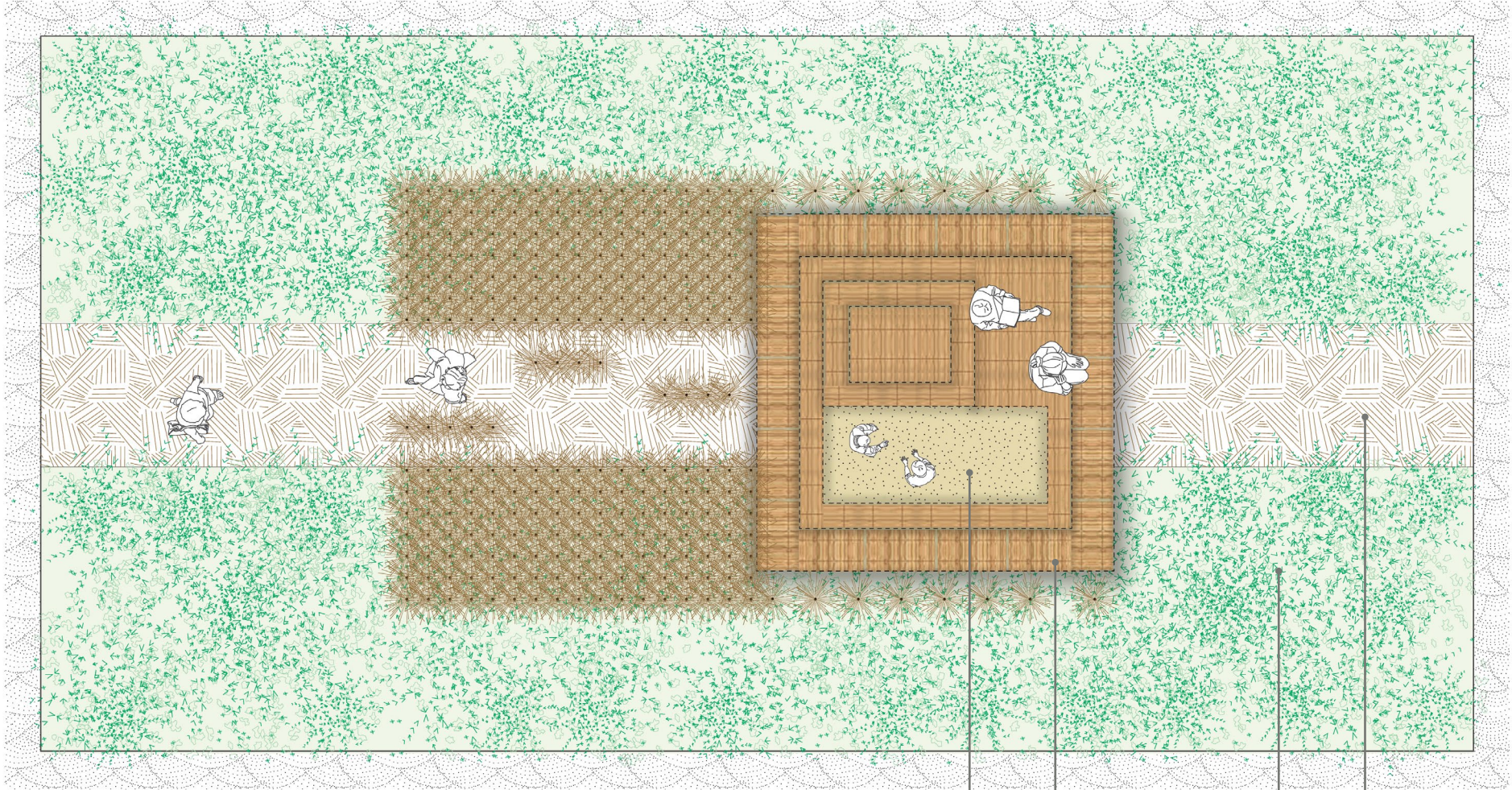


The Riddle of Nature

“The Riddle of Nature” is an exploration of the possibility of ecology. Human and nature are originally in the same unified ecosystem. However, with the wheel of time, the relationship between man and nature become unprecedently complex and antagonistic. The uncertainty of different permutations and combinations give rise to new possibilities for the ecosystem.

By engaging this nature riddle, visitors can figure out their own understanding and relationship with nature. The garden envisions the simplest future possibility that the balance would go back to its purest origin. This is a short-term action for a long term future, designing with all the nature materials that could nourish the ecosystem from the garden’s birth to death.

From the section of the garden, the entrance on one end represents the birth of humanity; The stack of haystacks in the middle represents the interaction between nature and human; Walking through the grains, which symbolize nature, slowly transitions to the other entrance, representing a human’s return to the nature.



Site Plan

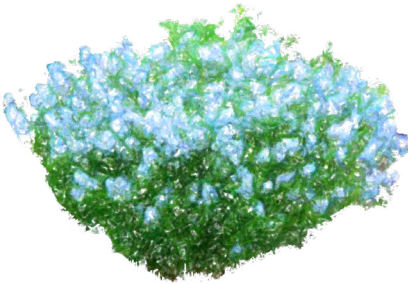

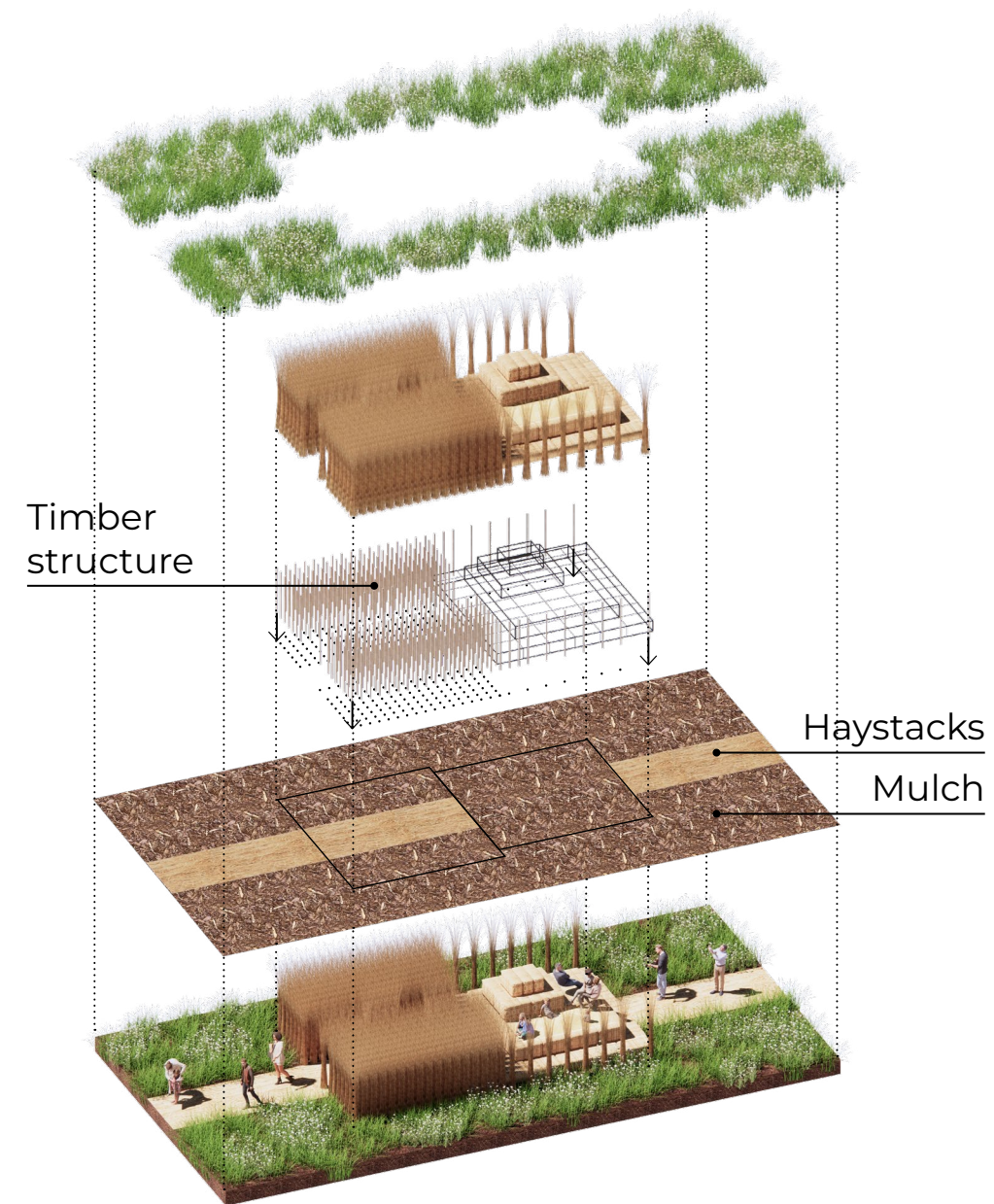
