

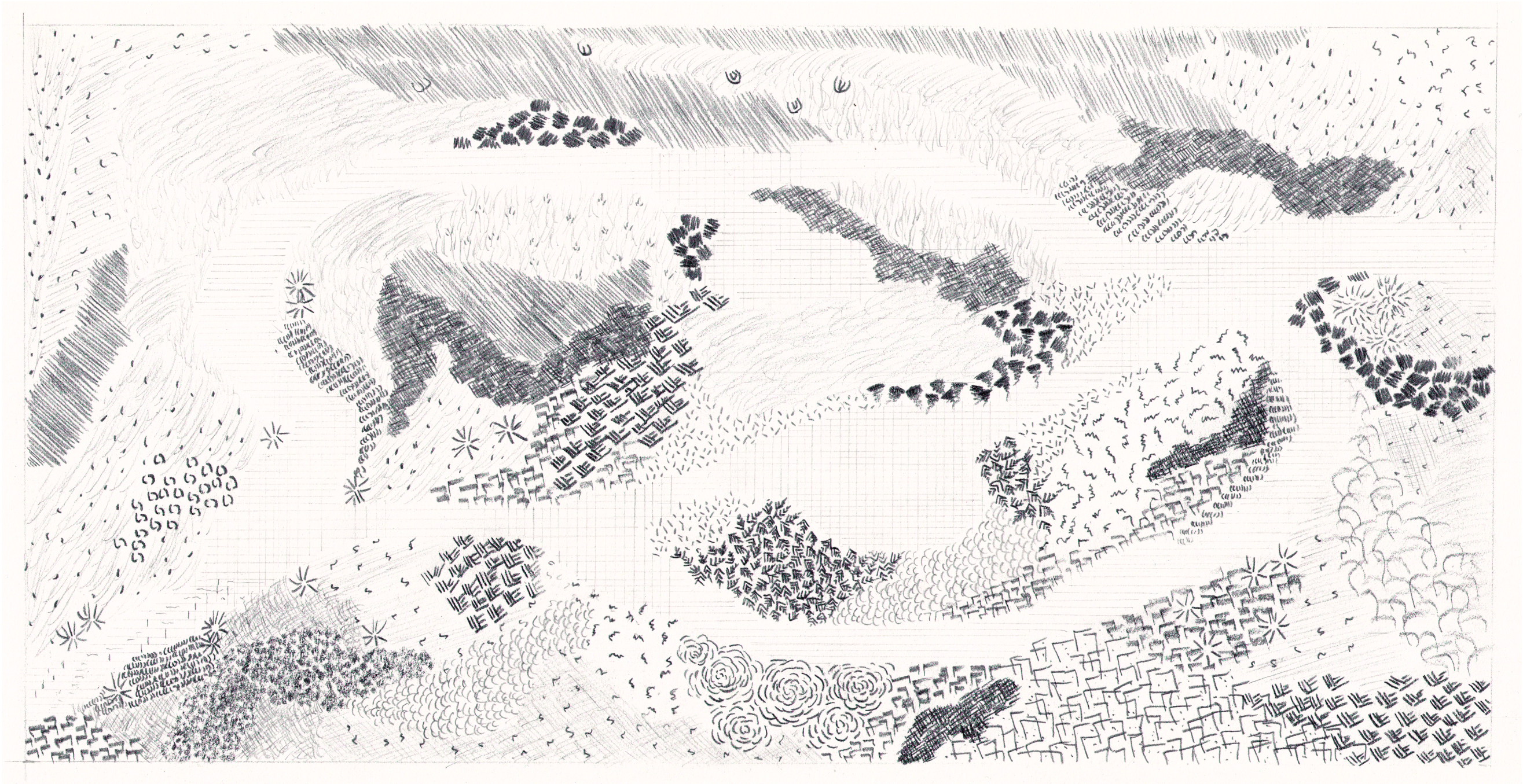


## Sursurrus

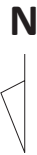
This garden physically manifests the idea of possibility and, over time, will reflect the shifting and melding of possibility and dreams. The charred, flat shou sugi ban path gives a sense of depth and space extending into the earth and transports the passerby through the garden of dreams. Plant selections on the raised earth plays on the metaphorical sense of possibility with cloud-like grasses, drifting through one another and over time blending with one another. Below, the contrasting plants and triadic colors of the plants appeal to the subconscious senses but also invoke the latent potential in the sense of “possibility”. Staccato, structural plants interplay with soft, rounded plants while a handful of unique, self-seeding annuals interwoven with hardy perennials represent the resiliency and interspersing qualities inherent in possibility. As the garden grows and changes, so it will also represent the growth and changes of possibility we experience through time as people. In these ways, this garden embodies the sense of possibility we experience throughout our lives from birth until death.
