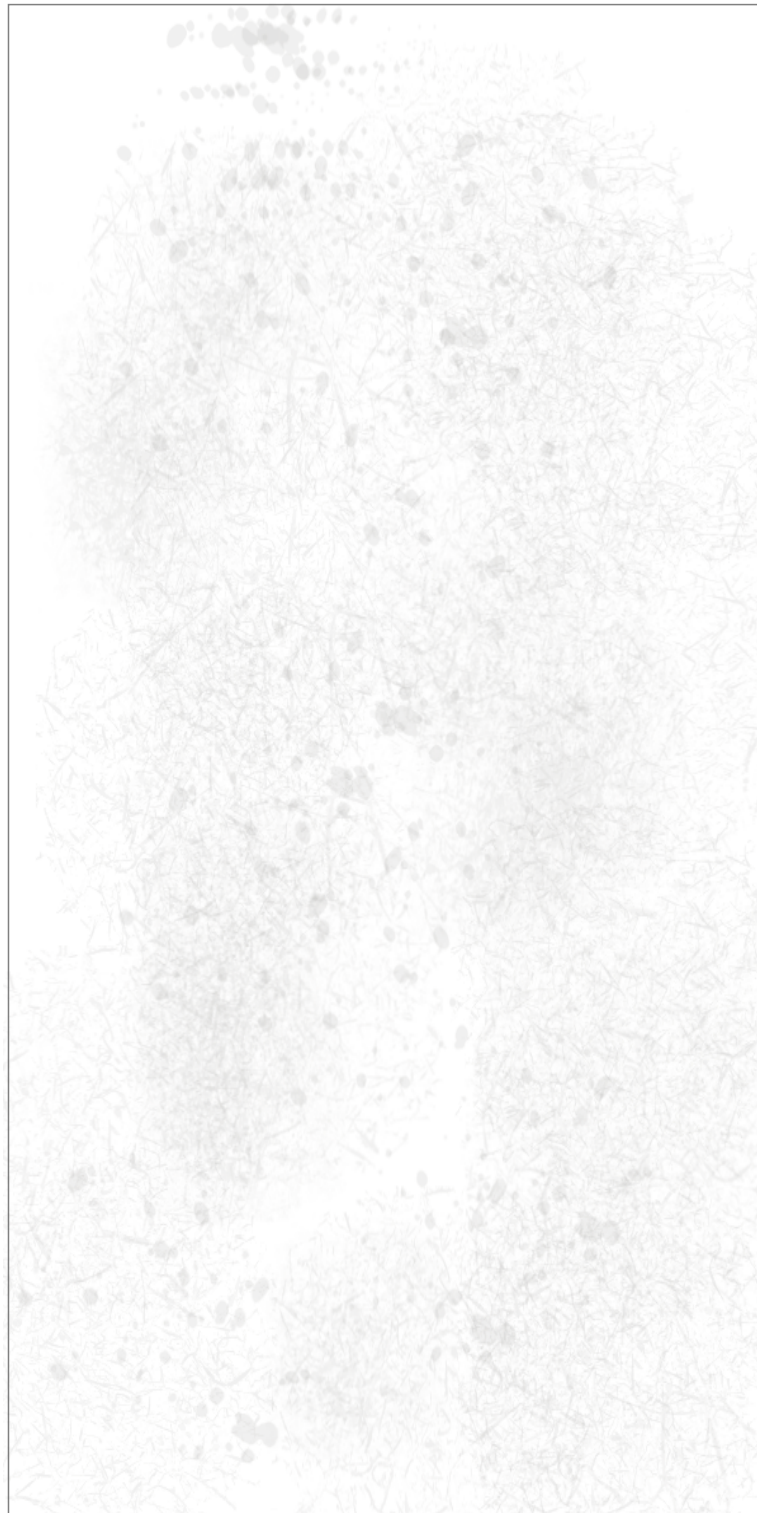

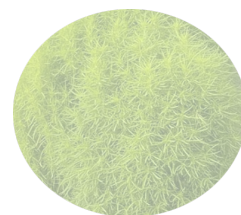

This garden allows us to increase our abilities of our imaginations. It invites to create the space and borders as we wish, as it suits us the best. We can arrange the boxes with plants as borders of smaller rooms or create one big or build only a partial wall. Or use a rake and create borders on ground level only. Or mix both resources.

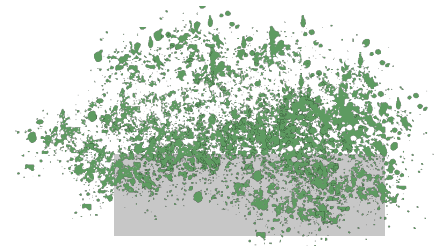

The rest depends on guests.

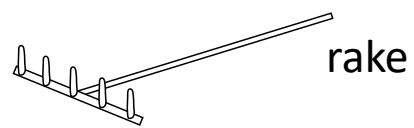
