 — Public and private among natural landscape

Nowadays, people's demands of the **public** and **private** degree of public toilet space are complex and ambivalent: People often desire both privacy and socialization. As one of important sites for our public life, parks' toilets are often crowded and isolated. How to adjust public (privacy) degree to meet our psychological needs?

We choose to use spiral forms to create **multilayer spaces with different public (privacy) levels**. People with different demands can find comfortable status. **Spiral curve with solid wall, frosted glass and grille**, which is **contradictory** and **varied**, map and adapt our ambivalent psychological needs, and improve the inclusiveness and publicity of public toilets.
