THE HIDDEN DIVIDE

"The Hidden Divide" immerses visitors in an interactive labyrinth where mirrored panels interrupt a continuous path, leading them on a journey to the center. Along the way, mirrors block pathways, forcing visitors to pivot each one to proceed. Yet each movement shifts the reflections and obstructs other paths, illustrating how the invisible boundaries we create reshape both our own journeys and those of others.

As visitors engage with the mirrors, they experience the interplay of self, nature, and the impact of their actions, seeing reflections of surrounding greenery, other participants, and themselves. This act of shifting mirrors becomes a powerful metaphor for borders—unseen yet influential, restrictive yet changeable, affecting movement and connection alike.

Reaching the central clearing, visitors find a space of stillness after navigating the labyrinth, prompting reflection on the collective impact of boundaries and the nature of shared freedom. "The Hidden Divide" challenges visitors to contemplate how boundaries, both personal and societal, mold our interconnected lives, encouraging a deeper dialogue on freedom and choice.
