As these plots of land are revisited by humans time and time again they remind us of more than its botanical or scientific inquires. These landscapes being far beyond their physical scope.


For J. A Baker a place can be defined by the natural light that shines through it - where one can find refuge, seclution and healing.







Circulation diagram Ground plan


Direct sun light path / Reflective plate Sec a'a






