

Su-style vernacular garden




On the premise of respecting the plant form of the space itself, the vernacular garden full of wild interest is constructed to arouse people's memory of Suzhou and arouse people's interest and exploration of local plants in Suzhou.

In the construction of rural plant landscape, Suzhou native plant species with strong resistance and few pests and diseases are used as the main body to build a stable planting structure foundation.

Local plants and aquatic plants, ornamental herbs and flowers are used to build a stable plant community with fewer diseases and pests, so as to reduce the maintenance cost, effectively improve the species diversity, and show the local landscape characteristics.

Suzhou is located in the North subtropical humid monsoon climate zone. It is warm, wet and rainy, with obvious monsoon and four distinct seasons. Winter and summer are long and spring and autumn are short. The average frost-free period lasts 233 days a year. Due to the differences in terrain, latitude and so on, the formation of a variety of unique microclimates. Therefore, plants such as *Pterocarya stenoptera* and *Vaccinium bracteatum* are often used. Among them, *Pterocarya stenoptera* faster, its branches are coiled and the crown has
