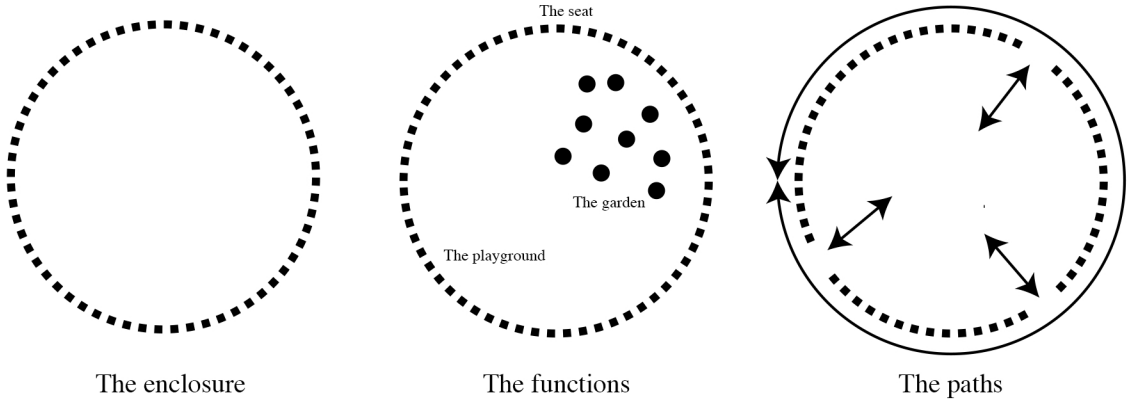


WELCOME, YELLOW BRICKS GARDEN



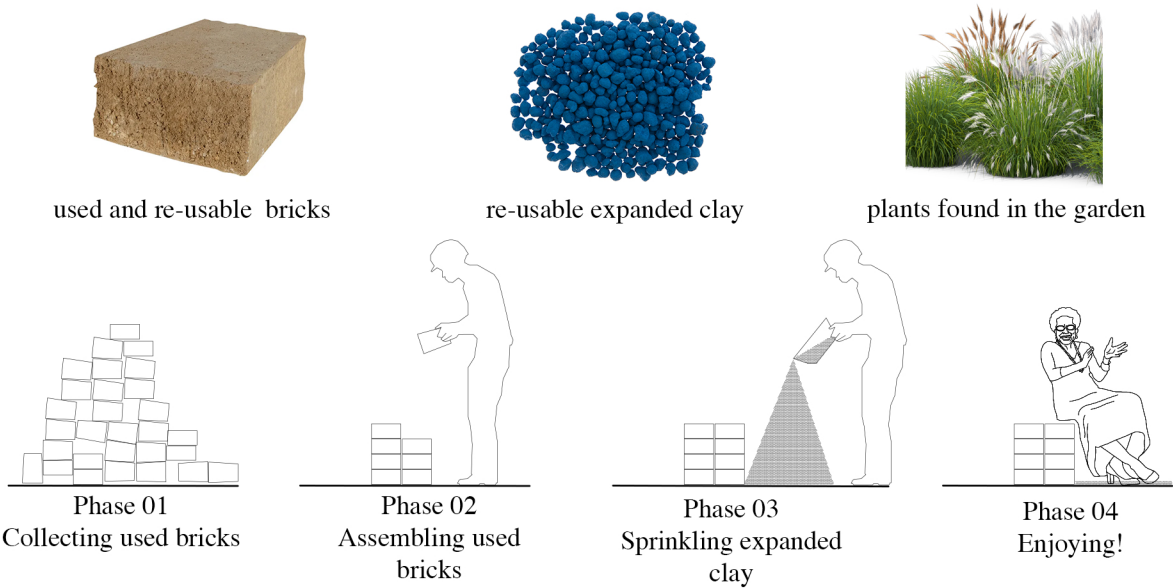
The idea of this project is born from the concept of the “as found” born in England in the fifties. The “as found” is an entryway into the unlimited world of limited possibilities. The answer to the matter “The Ecology of Possibility” is found in the vision that we could work with something that we already have.

With a circle, made up of re-used concrete bricks without mortar and expanded colored clay, a garden within the garden it’s created. It can be placed everywhere in the existing garden, encircling the existing plants and re-built as many times as wanted. A place abstracted from the surrounding garden, an “interior” space where to sit, to walk, to observe the flowers. This experience will be intense and memorable, as will the materials themselves – full of memory and time.

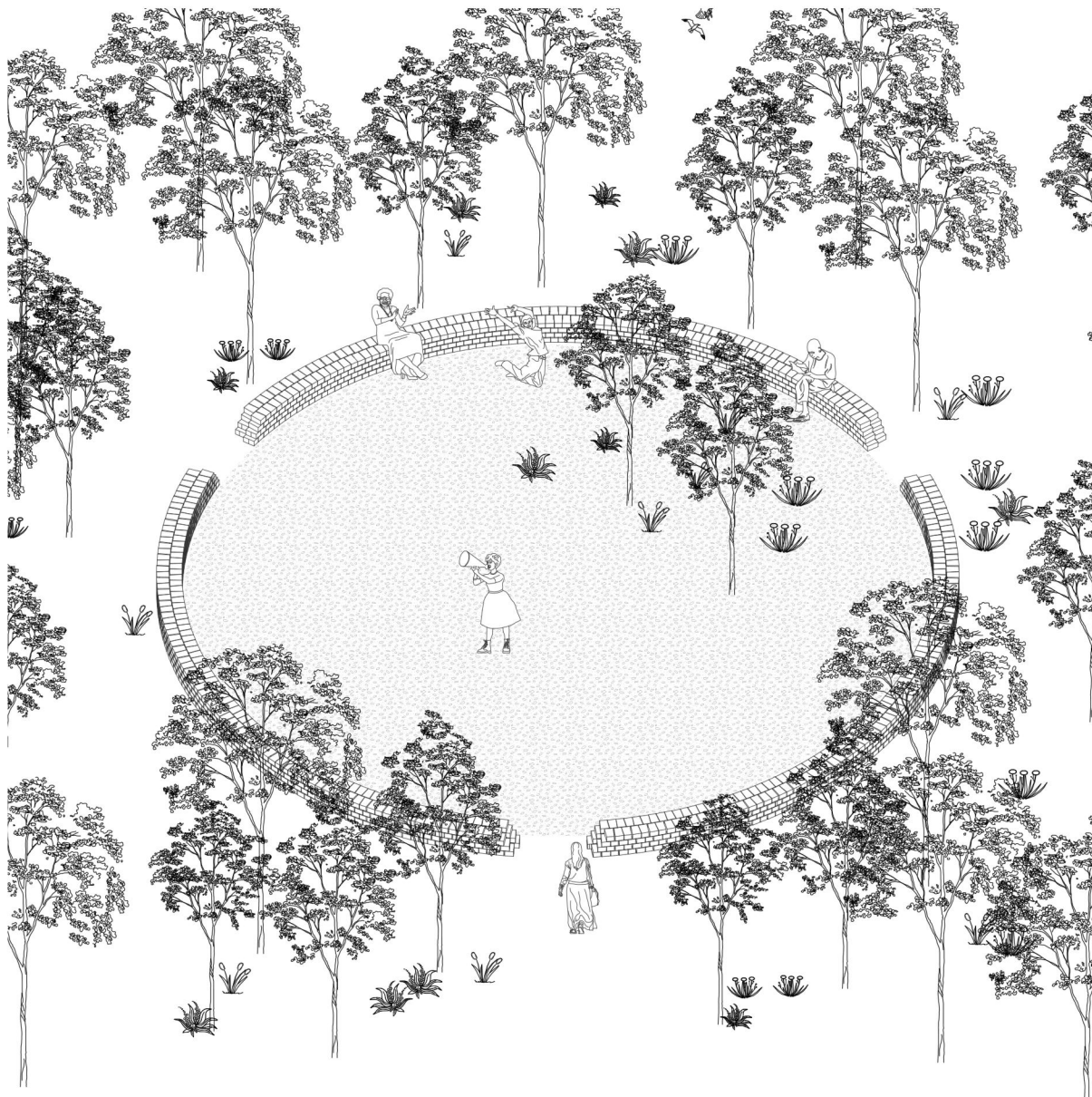
