

The project stands as a place designed to explore the paradox of seclusion and segregation, often associated with separation, here are reimagined to cultivate unity, reflection, and community. Within this structure, boundaries transcend the idea of barriers, transforming into zones of invitation and convergence, balancing solitude and togetherness and encouraging a sense of shared introspection. Along its borders, a sequence of ropes creates intimate spaces for contemplation, while in-between areas provide points of gathering for reflection in solitude, yet always within reach of others, allowing the boundary to act as a connection between individuality and community. Through these spaces, strangers are invited to connect, pause, and grow.

Also serves as a dynamic space for learning and exchange, gently inviting visitors to challenge their perceptions of borders, seeing them as places of welcome and union rather than separation, embodying the idea of a boundary that merges individual identity with collective belonging.

Therefore, it becomes more than an architectural form—it transforms into a metaphor for unity forged through thoughtful separation, shifting from a feeling of isolation to an opportunity for connection.

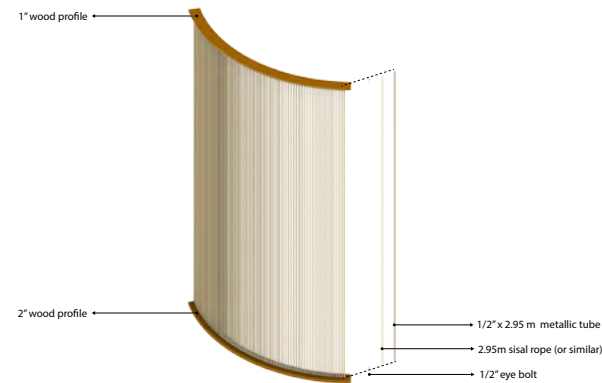

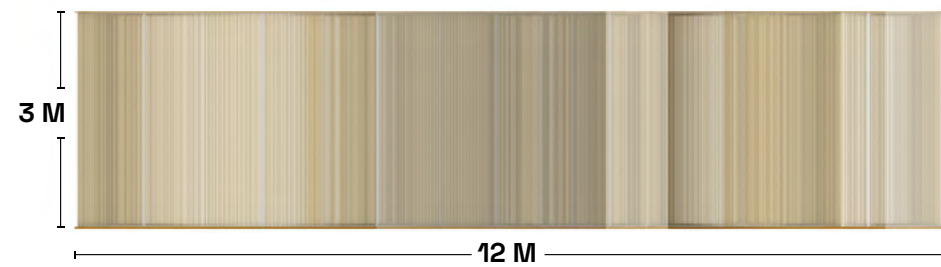

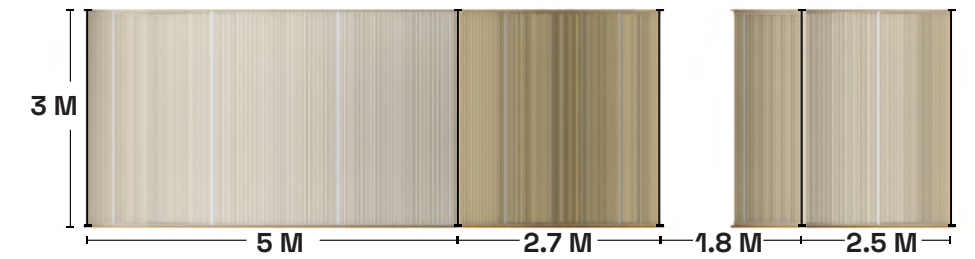
Aerial view
