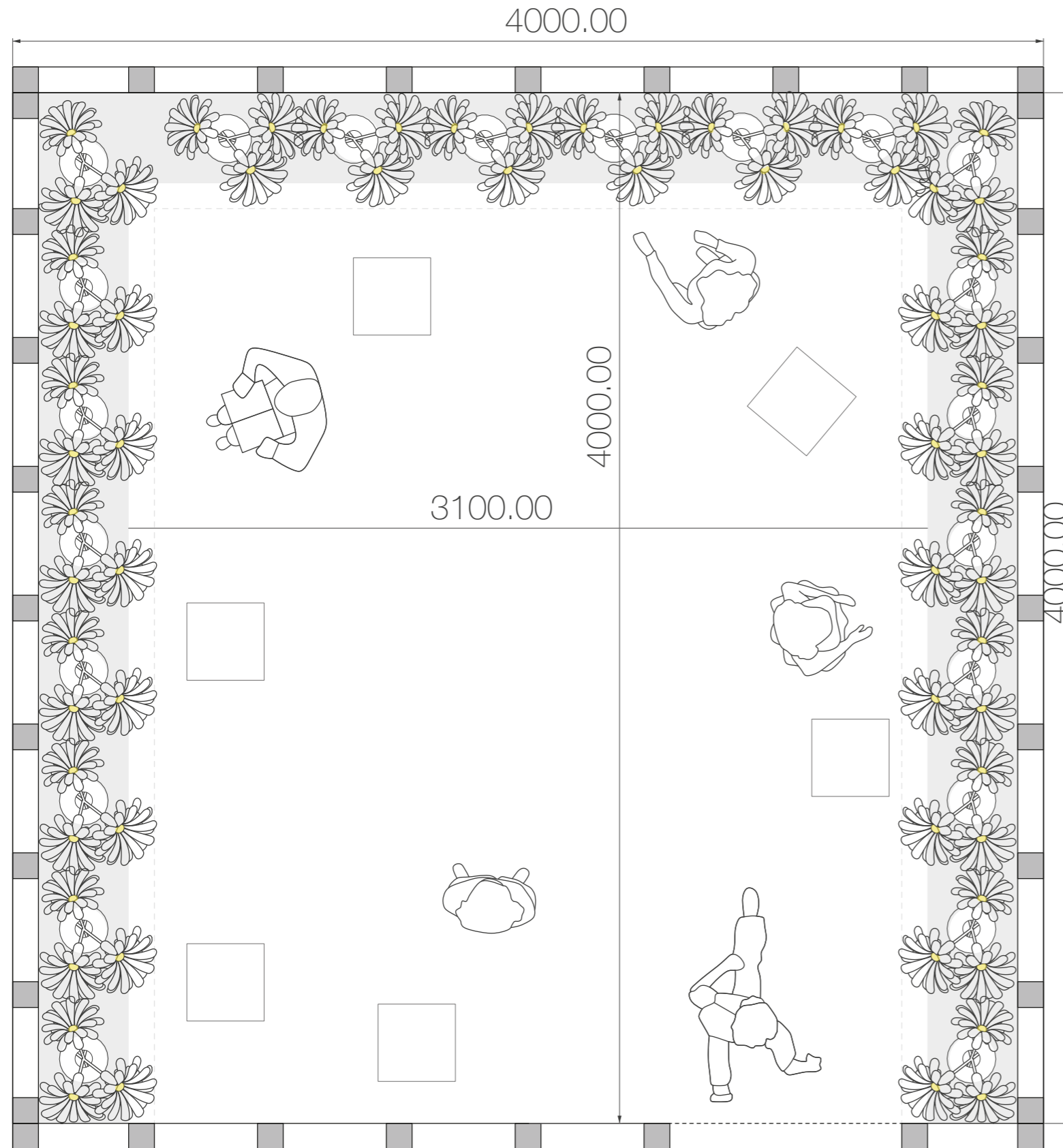
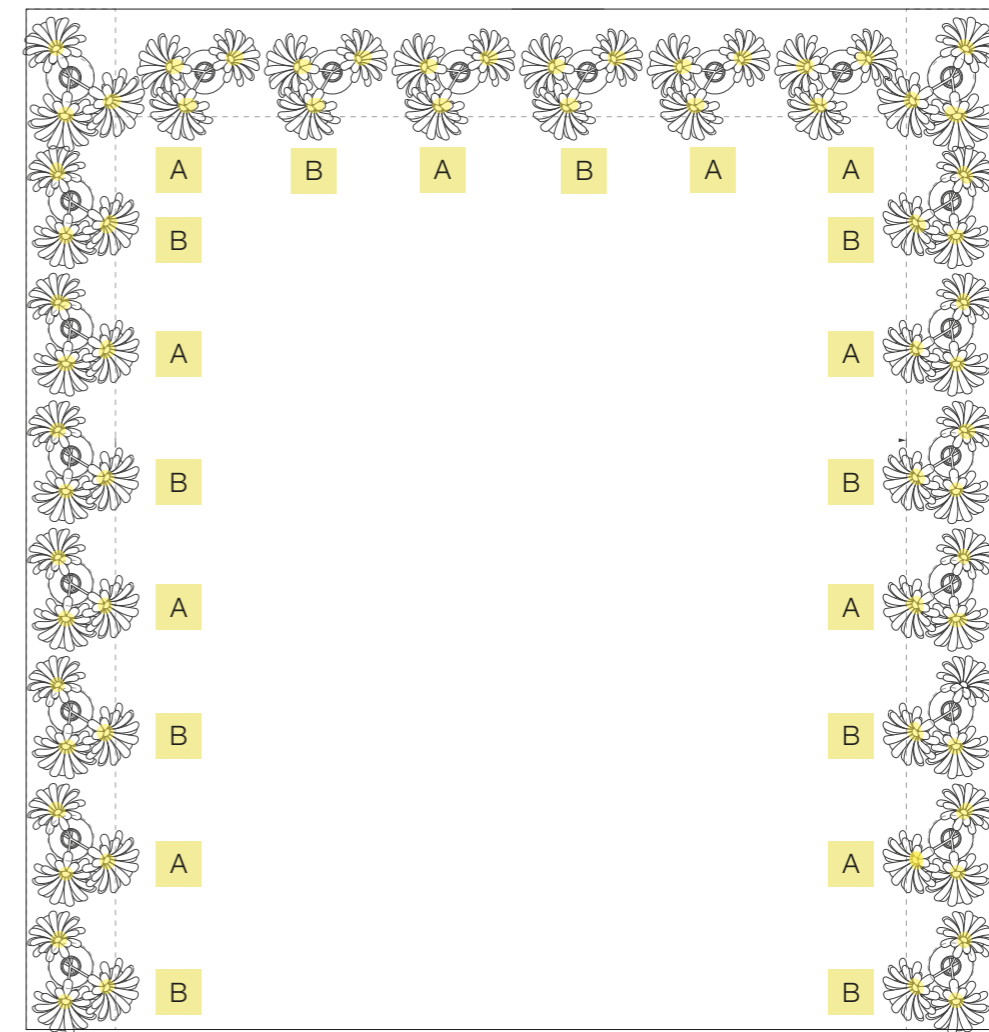


THE INTERIOR GARDEN

THE INTERIOR GARDEN is a garden that takes us back to when spices from other countries were transported in live plant transport boxes, so the metaphor of crossing borders is transformed into a 4x4m interior garden space within a larger garden. The selection of plants is arranged and perceived to transmit a sensorial, olfactory and harmonious experience to the visitor. The visitor enters a space where they can enjoy the vibrant atmosphere, the natural light manifests itself in shadows and light throughout the day produced by the open grid roof accompanied by the light, completely wooden structure of the space, without cladding, but with vegetation on both sides that intertwine the continuity of vegetation manifested on the inner edge, these conditions allow the visitor to enjoy an interior and exterior space at the same time. When night falls, small lamps softly illuminate the garden, providing a warmth that transforms the place into a refuge for both flora and the visitor.

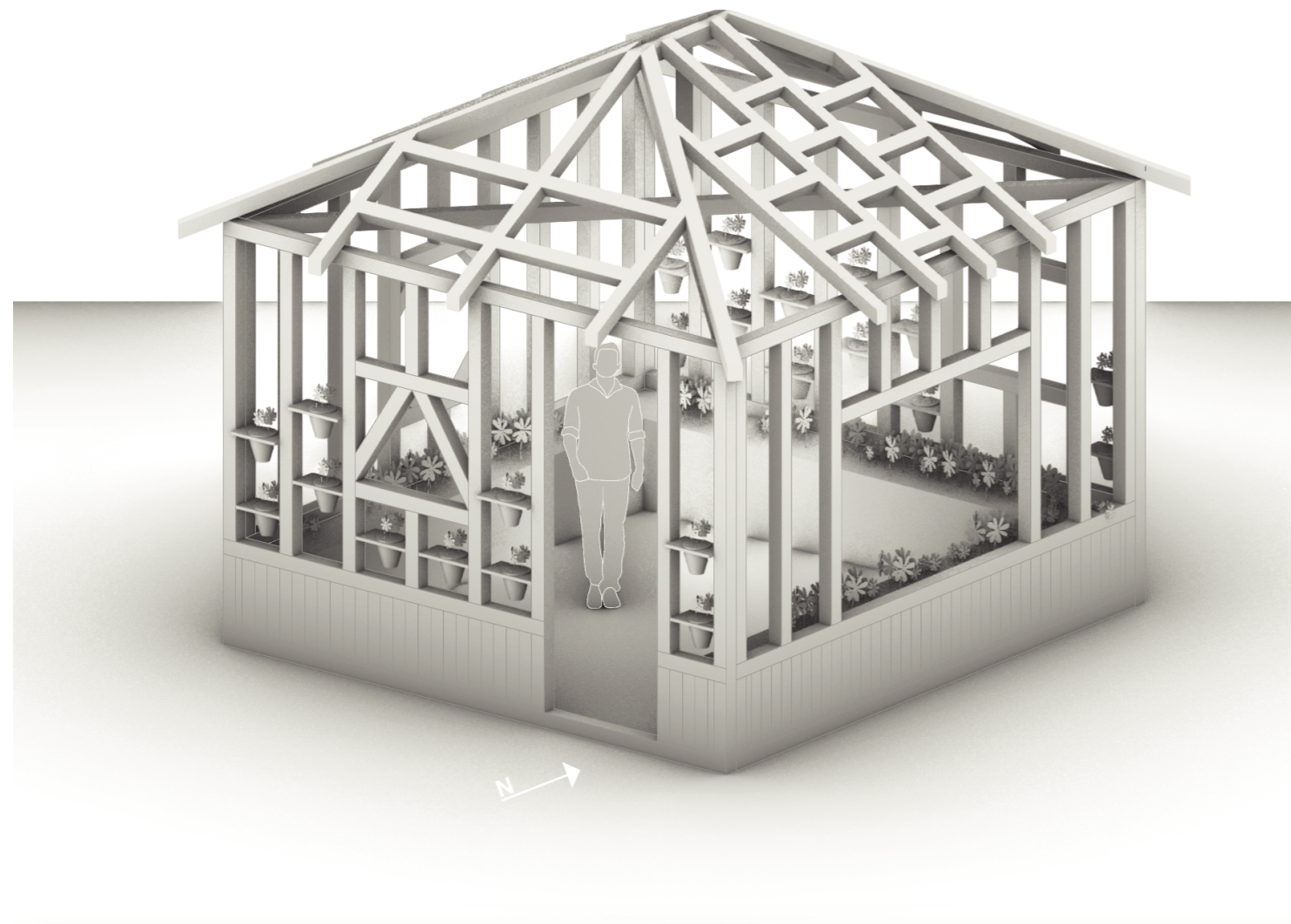


Floor plan of the plants layout

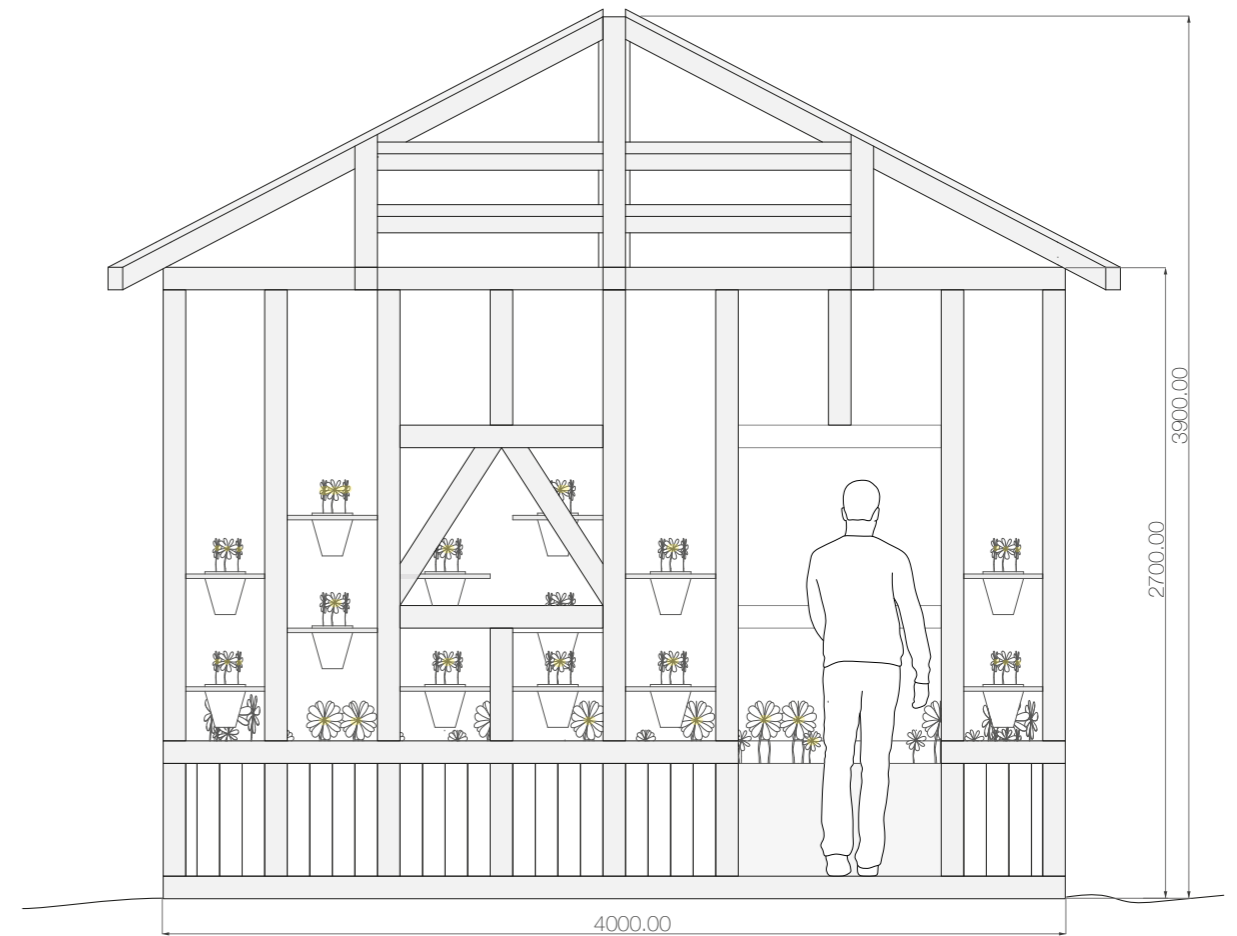
Selection of plants that grow between 70 cm - 1m, with yellow and white flowers, abundant green leaves. A-B

- B- *Chrysanthemum* - Asteraceae

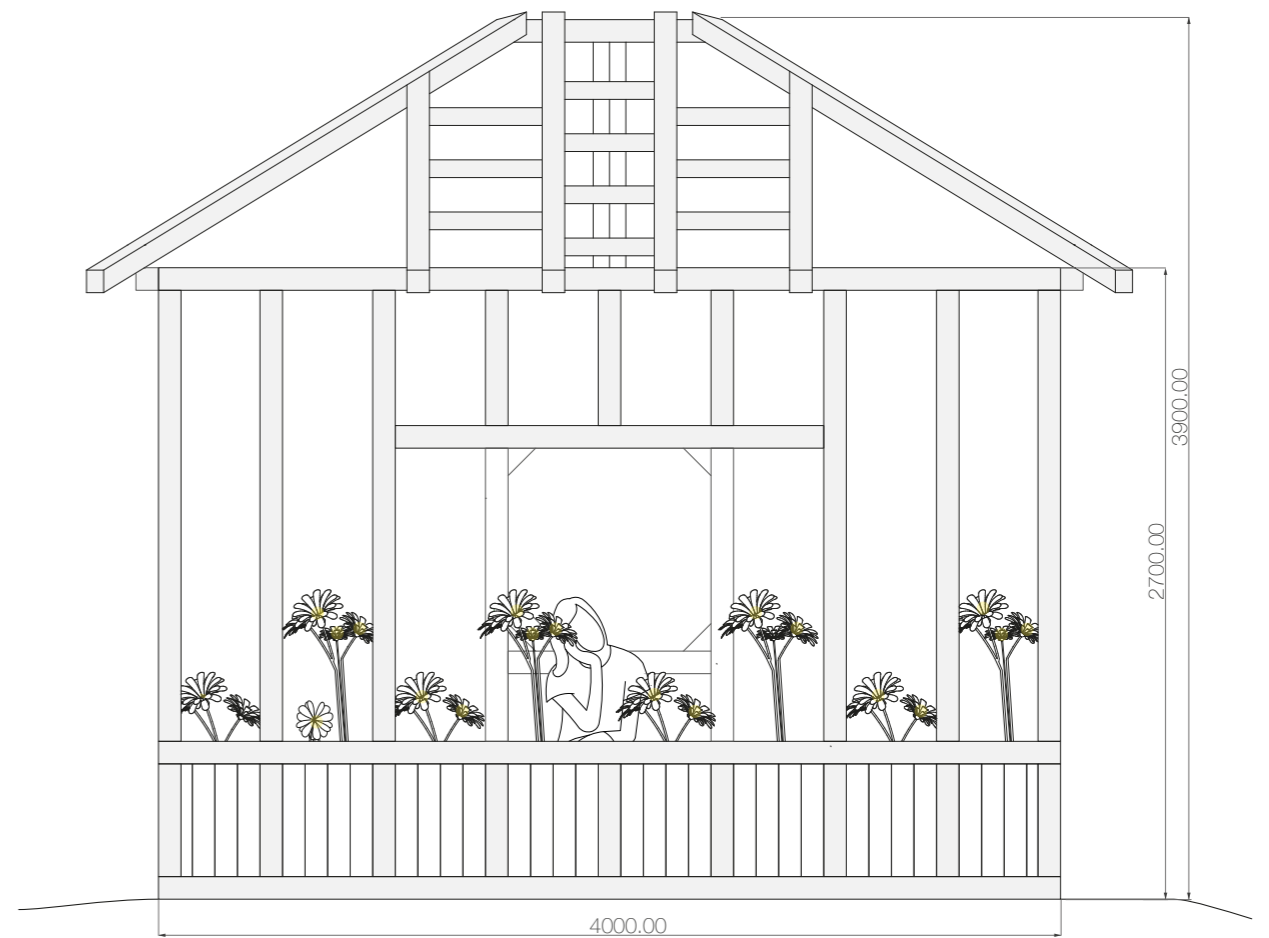
