
"DANCING CURTAIN"



· DESIGN DESCRIPTION

BORDER: DANCING CURTAIN.

THE CURTAIN SOFTLY DISTINGUISHES PRIVATE FROM PUBLIC, SUNLIGHT FROM SHADE.

A CIRCLE OF WATER CURTAINS IS SET UP AT THE OUTERMOST EDGE OF THE SITE. WHEN THE FOUNTAIN IS TURNED ON, THE SITE IS INACCESSIBLE, AND PEOPLE CAN WATCH THE SCENERY FROM THE OUTSIDE ONLY. THE FOUNTAIN IS CONTROLLED BY SIMULATING THE RHYTHM OF HUMAN HEARTBEAT THROUGH EQUIPMENT AND MUSIC. WHEN THE FOUNTAIN IS TURNED OFF, VISITORS CAN ENTER TO INTERACT, CULTIVATE CROPS AND BUILD GARD ENS, PLAY SKATEBOARDS, AND WATCH EXHIBITIONS.


THE MAIN FRAME SIMULATES THE SHAPE OF A HALF-OPEN CURTAIN WITH WOOD, GUIDING VISITORS TO EXPLORE AND VISIT THE EXHIBITION. ONE SIDE OF THE FRAME IS USED FOR GARDEN CULTIVATION, AND THE OTHER SIDE IS USED FOR SKATEBOARD PARKS, BOTH OF WHICH CAN BE CO-CREATED AND CO-BUILT WITH TOURISTS TO MEET THE NEEDS OF PEOPLE OF DIFFERENT AGES.

THE WOODEN POLES ARE EASY TO BUILD THROUGH SIMPLE METAL RIVETING, AND CAN BE DISASSEMBLED AND REASSEMBLED OR RECYCLED IN OTHER PUBLIC INSTALLATIONS OR CONSTRUCTION LATER, WHICH IS ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY AND ECOLOGICAL.
