


# SENSITIVITEA GARDEN

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The *Sensitivitea Garden* is an Afrofuturist tea garden nested within a labyrinth of wattle fences of varying heights, creating a sense of rhythm and movement through space. The planting palette is composed of edible and medicinal species that can be harvested for tea, grounding the garden in sensory and reciprocal relationships with the land. As visitors wind through a series of narrow paths, they are invited to slow down into a state of meditative playfulness where intentional movement and orientation become forms of reflection and presence.

At the heart of the garden, an open circular space offers a place for gathering, sharing and connection (over a cup of tea). This gathering place acts as a place dedicated for conversation, ceremony, and belonging. The garden's design invites sensitivity as a practice: to move slowly, to notice the living textures of wattle and colorful plants, and to be guided by curiosity. Through this immersive experience, The *Sensitivitea Garden* is an embodied invitation to reconnect with the land and with one another through movement, play, and shared presence.


