


VOYAGEURS

A rich history of exploration following the flowing rivers of the region is the source of inspiration for this dynamic garden adventure. Voyageurs borrows from the spirit of early travelers that relied on intuitive understanding of the landscape, using their observational skills to navigate wild and remote areas. Often critical to survival, sense of direction and

experiential memory of trade routes became a valuable tool in establishing early connections between communities, facilitating the exchange of essential resources and ideas.

Visitors are welcome to walk the crushed granular pathways through the curving plant drifts blooming with blue and white flowers reminiscent of strong river currents. Amongst these weaving plant mounds are three heritage style wood canoes that offer a chance to sit and view the garden from an entirely different perspective. These seating vessels allow for a slower and more immersive experience focused on the ecology of the garden. Additionally, a series of decorative features help accentuate movement and form. Blue wave fins and reflective cut outs add colour and interest especially during shoulder seasons while the planting is in transition.






STAINLESS STEEL 'FISH' CUT OUTS
