


GROUND CANOPY СВОИД СМОБУ

This garden composes plants, structures, light, and shadow into subtle dialogue, grounded in the responsive nature of the terrain. Sensitivity here is not mere reaction, but a refined awareness — a way of perceiving rhythm and presence through distance. Like the phenomenon of Crown Shyness, where treetops keep graceful intervals in the air, this landscape nurtures an etiquette of distance upon the ground, where separation does not mean isolation. Wind, light, moisture, and footsteps drift softly across the surface, altering its temperature and texture. At times, a thin mist veils the air, diffusing light and softening boundaries, expanding the sensory horizon of the space. Through these quiet transitions, Ground Canopy reimagines the earth as a living, breathing membrane — an organism of responsiveness where sight, touch, and breath converge within a sensitive distance.
