

The Sky We Share

This installation invites visitors to pause, lie back, and contemplate our shifting relationship with the sky — once a boundless symbol of freedom, dreams, and divine presence, now often marked by fear, pollution, and conflict. The same sky that nourishes life with sunlight and rain has become, for many, a place of surveillance and destruction — a sky of falling bombs instead of falling stars.

At the center, plants quietly reclaim the space, reminding us of nature’s resilience and our shared dependence on this vast, fragile dome. The circular form embraces visitors, offering an inclination to rest and gaze upward.

After contemplation, each person is invited to leave a trace with a black marker — to answer on the outer walls: When did you last feel threatened by the open sky? or simply, How does the sky make you feel today?

These reflections will gradually form a map of collective memory, revealing our emotional landscapes beneath the same sky we all share.




Salvia x Sylvestris - 'May night'




Iris Sibirica - 'Caesar's brother'




Alchemilla Mollis - Lady's mantle
