


The Moon Arcana Garden

Concept

The **Moon Arcana Garden**, inspired by **Major Arcana XVIII**, symbol of sensitivity, intuition, transformation, and the subconscious, invites visitors to cross a delicate **threshold between reality and dream**. It immerses them in a **suspended landscape** where **water** becomes a **space of resonance**, reflection, and mystery.


Wooden walkways, marked by symbolic **timber portals**, seem to float on a reflective water surface that embraces the entire garden, guiding visitors towards the heart of the installation. The central **Moon iron artifact** emerges from the mirror-like pool, surrounded by the intoxicating scent of **aquatic and medicinal plants** linked to-and esoteric rituals. The circular path around it is interrupted by water thresholds, suggesting the transition from the material world to the sensitive and emotional realm, encouraging visitors to tune into their most **intimate perceptions**.

Vertical mirrors placed at the end of the walkways expand the visual field and **create illusions** of depth, while **small floating mirrors** refract light in multiple directions.

Crossing the **Moon Arcana Garden** means **being led by the Moon's reflection**, where **the real and the imaginary merge into a single poetic and sensorial experience**.


Main View 1
